- Lent runs from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's Supper exclusive on Holy Thursday. Fasting during Lent for Adults ages 18-59 is required on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday. Abstinence from eating meat is essential on all Friday's during Lent and Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The prayer of the Stations of the Cross is observed in our Parish during Lent after the Friday morning mass and Friday at 6pm. On the fourth Sunday of Lent (Laetare) rose colored vestments are used at mass to signify the theme of anticipated rejoicing as Lent enters it's final weeks.
- We will have Soul Sisters on February 21st instead of February 14th due to that day being Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day. We will also play bingo at our next meeting.
