#### • Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word:

Today's first and second readings, no matter which ones are chosen, prepare us for Jesus' baptism. Isaiah prophesied the Messiah, one who would bring peace and justice to the world. The early Christian community recognized the salvation they had received through baptism, salvation available to all. Then Saint Luke describes the Holy Spirit descending like a dove upon Jesus as he was praying after his baptism. As we listen, let us realize that the Holy Spirit descended upon us as well when we were baptized.
