- Traditions/Practices of Lent in the Catholic Church
 Lent runs from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's
 Supper exclusive on Holy Thursday. Fasting during Lent
 for Adults, ages 18-59 is required on Ash Wednesday and
 Good Friday. Abstinence from eating meat is essential on
 all Friday's during Lent, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
 The prayer of the Stations of the Cross is observed in our
 Parish during Lent after the morning mass and Friday at
 6:00 PM. On the fourth Sunday of Lent (Laetare) rose
 colored vestments are used at mass to signify the theme of
 anticipated rejoicing as lent enters its final weeks.
